MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

After a very successful 1981 meeting in Hamilton, Ontario hosted by Drs. Bob Carlone and Michel Rathbone, preliminary arrangements have been made for the Fourth Biennial Forum on Regeneration to be held from June 2-4, 1983 at the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, Illinois. The organizers are Drs. David L. Stocum (Department of Genetics and Development, University of Illinois) and Charles E. Dinsmore (Department of Anatomy, Rush Medical College, Chicago). The June date was selected to avoid conflict with meetings of the AAAS, Teratologists, and Mid-West Regional Development Biology Conference.

In keeping with established tradition, the meeting will be quite informal. To minimize costs, participants will be housed in dormitories and can take meals in local establishments, of which there are many on and near campus. A social hour sponsored by the Department of Genetics and Development will be held on the evening of June 2. The talks will be held in one of the classrooms. Speakers will be allowed 15-30 minutes (depending on the number of persons who wish to talk), and audio-visual equipment and blackboards will be available.

All persons interested in attending the Forum are requested to fill out the enclosed form by November 30, 1982. A second letter will be sent in February 1983 to those who respond, with information about registration, housing costs and travel access to Urbana-Champaign. At that time, we will request the formal title of your talk, if you decide to give one. A program will then be made up and mailed in April 1983 to those who indicate that they will attend.


We are currently seeking sources of support to defray local expenses for participants, but we do not at this time anticipate being able to provide funds to defray travel costs.
