

SECOND ADDENDUM TO BIBLIOGRAPHY  
OF WORKS OF R. R. HUMPHREY

Even as amended in the spring, 1979 Newsletter, the bibliography of Humphrey's work - begun in the fall, 1978 issue - remains incomplete. Dr. Hobart Smith of the University of Colorado, Boulder has kindly directed our attention to the following two abstracts not previously listed:

1942. Sex reversal and the genetics of sex determination in the axolotl (Amblystoma mexicanum). *Anat. Rec.*, 82 (Supplement 3): 77.
1946. The ovaries in triploid axolotl females of different genotypes with respect to sex chromosomes. (Abstract) *Anat. Rec.*, 94 (3): 472.

(This brings Humphrey's lifetime total to 94 items, but not all of these concern axolotls.)

The above references come from a book highly recommended to anyone interested in published material on the axolotl:

This contains 3,311 references, as well as an excellent introduction, and is invaluable as a literature review.
